Note: Personalized license plates held at the County and not issued to the customer in the past 13-months shall be returned to the State Registration Section to ensure that the personalized plate program is properly updated permitting re-issuance of the personalized plate. Any personalized plate not returned will not be removed from the personalized plate program or re-issued to avoid duplicate plates. Personalized license plates should be recorded on a separate log from all other scrap plates, and returned with the plates to State Registrations Section.
Completed log shall be submitted to the State Registration Section at least quarterly starting with the approval date of the DR 2926 License Plate Destruction, Recycling \& Disposal Approval Application. If no license plates were destroyed, recycled or disposed of, a log sheet shall be submitted with "No Scrap Plates This Quarter" as the first entry. Separate lists may be attached to this form.
