A Colorado Driver License, Record, Identification and Vehicle Enterprise Solution End User License Agreement (EULA). Failure to complete and submit this to the Department on an annual basis will result in being removed from the authorization list for all abandoned tow procedures

Provide DOR with a copy of the Abandoned Vehicle Contract for each contracted Tow Carrier annually and when information changes.

C.R.S. 42-4-1813 allows law enforcement agencies to charge towing and storage fees based on contractual agreements with tow carriers.

DOR uses this information to comply with the PUC audit recommendations and to verify fees.

 Each Tow Carrier utilized in a Public Tow procedure is required to be registered with the PUC and the DOR Title Services Unit



Tow Carrier & Law Enforcement Annual Requirements

- Internet registration and search requests require
 - Annual update of the EULA
 - An email will be sent to the agency requiring the updated EULA
 - Need to be received by September 30, or become INACTIVE
 - Current contract with tow company

 - Failure to complete and submit this to the Department on an annual basis will result in being removed from the authorization list for all abandoned tow procedures





Abandoned Vehicles

What does "Abandoned Vehicle" mean?

Colorado Revised Statutes (C.R.S.)

42-4 Part 21 Vehicles Abandoned on Private Property

42-4 Part 18 Vehicles Abandoned on Public Property





C.R.S. 42-4-2101(1)(a)

Any motor vehicle left unattended on private property for a period of twenty-four hours or longer or for such other period as may be

established by local ordinance without the consent of the owner or lessee of such property or the owner's or lessee's legally authorized agent;





C.R.S. 42-4-2101(1)(b)

Any motor vehicle stored in an impound lot at the request of its owner or the owner's agent and not removed from the impound lot



according to the agreement with the owner or agent;



C.R.S. 42-4-2101(1)(c)

Any motor vehicle that is left on private property without the property owner's consent, towed at the request of the property owner, and not removed from the impound lot by the vehicle owner within


forty-eight hours;





C.R.S. 42-4-2101(1)(d)

A motor vehicle fitted with an immobilization device that is on private property and deemed to be abandoned pursuant to section 42-4-1105 (7)(c).





- Notify Law Enforcement within 30 minutes of tow And obtain a tow report number





Private Tow - Record Search

Record searches are to be completed within 2-10 calendar days

If a Colorado record is found you will send notifications to all listed owners and lenders.

Notify Owner/Lienholder

- Notice should:
 - Advise owner(s) & lienholder(s) that vehicles not claimed within 30 calendar days of the postmark on the notice will be disposed of
 - Indicate information about the vehicle can only be obtained from the responsible Tow Carrier



Notify Owner/Lienholder

- DR 2008A can be used as it contains the required information:
 - Contact information for Tow Carrier
 - Company name, PUC #, Address,
 Storage location, Phone Numbers
 - Tow Information



 Date of tow, location towed from, report number, law enforcement agency who determined it was not stolen



Vehicle Claimed


- Upon release by the Tow Carrier to the vehicle owner or lienholder of record:
 - Tow Carrier notifies responsible Law Enforcement Agency (LEA)
 - LEA adjusts or deletes entry in Colorado Crime Information Center System (CCIC)







Form DR 2173



 Sell the vehicle Not prior to 30 calendars days from the owner and/or lender notification But prior to 60 calendar days



Do not sell to

Vehicles cannot be sold to:

- Person that authorized the tow
- Any person with a proprietary interest in the tow operation
- Law Enforcement Agency (LEA) involved in tow process





Sale

- Sale of vehicles shall be in a commercially reasonable manner:
 - May be sold to a licensed motor vehicle dealer, wholesaler, or wholesale motor vehicle auction dealer
 - Through a classified newspaper advertisement published in Colorado for all vehicles sold to the general public
 - Notice must identify Tow Carrier and contact information
 - Identification of vehicle



Sale to Public

- Original Proof of Publication required
 - Must include:
 - Copy of the newspaper ad
 - Date(s) published
 - Name of newspaper
 - Electronic certification of ad is acceptable

Storage fees


When the Tow Carrier conducts a commercially reasonable sale and the vehicle does not sell the Tow Carrier may continue to collect storage fees for up to 120 days from the date of the publication in the newspaper ad



Fees / Balance

- When the purchase price of the vehicle exceeds the limits set forth by the PUC
 - The Tow Carrier or LEA must submit
 - 2 carbon copies of the DR2173
 - Balance from proceeds to:

P.O.BOX 173350, Room 147 Denver CO 80217-3350

- Within 30 days of date of sale
- When Vehicle Services audits these applications, this debt will be posted to the tow carrier account.



Fees / Balance

- Formula for auditing fees and sale of abandoned vehicle

 - Less Towing
 - Less Storage
 - Less Enforcement Expenditures
 - Less Processing
 - Less Other

 - Designate "Salvage" on the DR 2173 Motor Vehicle Bill of Sale
 - If Salvage
 - A DR 2704 Certified VIN Inspection required to determine if roadworthy
 - If roadworthy on DR 2704 Certified VIN Inspection
 - DR 2415 Rebuilt Title Established by Salvage Title Checklist
 - DR 2424 Rebuilt From Salvage Title Statement of Facts

Junk

- If appraised at \$350 or less
 - Must be sold as junk
 - NO Colorado Title will be issued
 - DR 2173 Motor Vehicle Bill of Sale
 - Clearly indicate "JUNK" or "NO TITLE".
 - A copy of the DR 2173 must be sent to the Department of Revenue, DMV, Title & Registration Section.
 - DOR will mark record "JUNK"





< 5 years old

- A Surety Bond is required when there is no CO record or out of state record found
 - The Tow Carrier or responsible LEA must provide to the buyer:
 - Original completed DR 2704
 Certified VIN Inspection
 - DR 2704 Certified VIN is valid for 1 year



< 5 years old

- A Surety Bond is required when No Colorado or National Record is found and the vehicle is less than 5 years old
 - The buyer applying for title must provide:
 - Surety Bond for twice the appraised value as shown on the DR 2173 Motor Vehicle Bill of Sale
 - Minimum Bond must be more than \$700.00
 - Tip: Bond Companies of this type are generally listed under Bonds – Surety
 - Colorado Title will be issued in name exactly as noted on the Surety Bond

- Retain information by LEA and Tow Carrier



Apply for Title

Purchaser makes application for title at the motor vehicle office in the county of residence.

- Secure and Verifiable Identification (SVID) is required to obtain a Title or Registration in the State of Colorado
 - DR 2841 Secure and Verifiable ID list of acceptable forms
- Required documents for title application will be verified for completion by the county motor vehicle office
- All title applications will be audited by the Department of Revenue in compliance with the PUC and statutory requirements

Auditing

Tips:

- Make sure all information is completed
 - Common errors:
 - Missing signatures
 - Dates missing or incomplete
 - Dates out of line / don't flow
 - Fields blank when should be N/A
 - Record Search included when shouldn't
- Verify required documents are being submitted
 - Use checklist as guide (DR 2992)





Auditing

Tips:

- Record Search results
 - Both "No Record Found" results <u>are</u> required to be submitted
- DPPA reminder
 - Do NOT share personal information
 - Tow Company retains information for 3 years
- Unusual circumstances should include a DR 2444
 Statement of Fact noting additional information and any documents related to reposting a newspaper ad

Colorado Revised Statutes (C.R.S.) 42-4-1802(8)

Property owned by

- The Federal Government
- The State of Colorado
- Any County
- Any Municipality





C.R.S. 42-4-1802(1)(a)

Any motor vehicle left unattended on public property, including any portion of a highway right-of-way, outside the limits of any incorporated town or city for a period of forty-eight (48) hours or longer





C.R.S. 42-4-1802(1)(b)

Any motor vehicle left unattended on public property, including any portion of a highway right-of-way, within the limits of any incorporated town or city for a period longer than any limit prescribed by any local ordinance concerning the abandonment of motor vehicles, or if there is no such ordinance, for a period of forty-eight hours (48) or longer;



C.R.S. 42-4-1802 (1)(c)

Any motor vehicle stored in an impound lot at the request of a law enforcement agency and not removed from the impound lot within seventy-two (72) hours after the time the law enforcement agency notifies the owner or agent that the vehicle is available for release upon payment





C.R.S. 42-4-1802 (1)(d)

Any motor vehicle fitted with an immobilization device that is on public property and deemed to be abandoned pursuant to C.R.S. 42-4-1105(7)(c);





C.R.S. 42-4-1802 (1)(e)

Any motor vehicle left unattended at a regional transportation district parking facility as defined in C.R.S. 32-9-119.9(6), that is deemed abandoned pursuant to C.R.S.

32-9-119.9(4)(b).

In some cases the vehicle is evidence or part of an investigation and will not be considered abandoned until after it has been released and the vehicle owner has not claimed the vehicle from impound.

This date is necessary for auditing purposes since a search cannot be performed until after the vehicle has been deemed abandoned.

Notify Owner/Lienholder

- When a Tow Carrier <u>IS NOT</u> used to store the motor vehicle
 - The LEA is required to send notification by certified mail





Notify Owner/Lienholder

- When a Tow Carrier <u>IS</u> used to store the motor vehicle
 - The Tow Carrier must send the notification by certified mail
 - With a return receipt
 - This occurs after the vehicle has been deemed abandoned and released from evidence



 LEA is required to notify the owner/lienholder and may do so by first class mail or certified mail



Notify Owner/Lienholder

- Notice should:
 - Advise owner(s) & lienholder(s) that vehicles not claimed within 30 calendar days of the postmark on the notice will be disposed of
 - Advise owner(s) & lienholder(s) of right to a hearing to determine legality of the towing
 - Request must have been made to the responsible LEA in writing and within 10 days of the postmark of the notice
 - Indicate that the vehicle can only be obtained from the responsible LEA and/or Tow Carrier
 - Responsible LEA and Tow Carrier shall retain proof of notification on file for 3 years



Notify Owner/Lienholder

- DR 2008A can be used as it contains the required information:
 - Contact information for Tow Carrier
 - Company name, PUC #, Address,
 Storage location, Phone Numbers
 - Tow Information
 - Date of tow, location towed from, report number, law enforcement agency who determined it was not stolen





Vehicle claimed


- Upon release by the Tow Carrier to the vehicle owner or lienholder of record:
 - Tow Carrier notifies responsible LEA
 - LEA adjusts or deletes entry in Colorado Crime Information Center System (CCIC)





 - If Salvage and appraised for \$350 or more
 - A DR 2704 Certified VIN Inspection is required to determine if roadworthy
 - If roadworthy on DR 2704 Certified VIN Inspection
 - DR 2415 Rebuilt Title Established by Salvage Title Checklist
 - DR 2424 Rebuilt From Salvage Title Statement of Facts

- Did record search show Salvage? Cont'd
 - If **not** roadworthy on **DR 2704** Certified VIN Inspection
 - DR 2410 Application for Salvage Title Or Nonrepairable Title



- The following documents or copies of should <u>NOT</u> be given to anyone else including a vehicle buyer.
 - Record search information indicating names and addresses of owner(s) and /or lienholder(s)
 - Notification letters
 - Certified mail information







Public Tow Apply for Title

Purchaser makes application for title at the motor vehicle office in the county of residence.

- Secure and Verifiable Identification (SVID) is required to obtain a title or registration in the State of Colorado
 - DR 2841 Secure and Verifiable ID list of acceptable forms
- Required documents for title application will be verified for completion by the county motor vehicle office
- All title applications will be audited by the Department in compliance with the PUC and statutory requirements



Public Tow Auditing

Tips:

- Make sure all information is completed
 - Common errors:
 - Missing signatures
 - Dates missing or incomplete
 - Dates out of line / don't flow
 - Fields blank when should be N/A
 - Record Search included when shouldn't
- Verify required documents are being submitted
 - Use checklist as guide



Auditing

Timeframe / Dates

- Deemed abandoned
- Record Search
- Notify Owner
- Wait 30 days
- Reasonable attempt to sell
- •Sell vehicle



Auditing

Tips:

- Record Search results
 - No Record Founds <u>are</u> required to be submitted
- DPPA reminder
 - Do NOT share personal information
 - LEA / Tow Company retains information for 3 years
- Unusual circumstances should include a DR 2444 Statement of Fact noting additional information and any documents related to reposting a newspaper ad
