Meeting Minutes

1. **Call to Order and Initial Business** – Chair at 9:10 am
 - a. Roll Call – Chris Hochmuth *a quorum was not present*

2. **New Business** – Dylan Ikenouye made and discussed the presentation below with the assistance of CCI Staff:

On October 14, 2020, Colorado Correctional Industries (CCI) suspended operations and the shipping of license plates and registration products due to high levels of staff and offender COVID-19 positive tests. After close to two months, CCI partially reopened on December 8, 2020.

The reduced crew is working on our outstanding year tab order. Due to the continuing COVID-19

situation, CCI is unable to process Print on Demand (POD) license plates. As of December 21, 2020 there is a backlog of 31,894 plates which increases between 600-700 plates every day. Due to the inability of CCI to provide POD license plates and the uncertainty of the COVID-19 situation within the Department of Corrections, the DMV would like to propose the temporary ceasing of all services that require a POD license plate.

We recognize there may be some counties using POD as a means to avoid employees coming into an office and there may be other situations of which we are not yet aware. Recognizing it will be difficult to schedule a meeting during the holidays, the DMV requests a meeting with the DRIVES

County Governance Committee and Colorado County Clerks Association Executive Committee during the regularly scheduled placeholder meeting on January 6, 2021 to discuss turning off POD

ordering in DRIVES until CCI can return to full production and work through the backlog of POD plates. If approved, all POD plates would be temporarily unavailable via transactions in DRIVES in the office or online.

Lengthy discussion ensued discussing various options: training of offenders and CCI staff, extending Temporary Permits and asking the Governor to allow longer than 60 days, permits tied to annual expiration date of plate, and/or more than 2 permits. Discussions also included how to deal with backlog. Ted wanted to know programming time lines and levels of effort from DRIVES.

- a. Committee Vote:
 - i. Turn off POD ordering in DRIVES until CCI can return to full production and work through the backlog?
 - ii. In lieu of the registration receipt, place a letter with each POD plate mailed



instructing the owner to go to eServices to obtain their registration receipt until the backlog is fully caught up and CCI is back to normal operations?

The Committee decided to refer this to RC&I for option development and then meet again on 1-12-2021 @ 3:30 pm. Additionally, they will reach out to CCA and the Governor's office. Motion passed unanimously.
