 - Flavio welcomed Adam back from Military leave and thanked Kevin for stepping up while he was gone. Chuck also thanked Kevin, and Adam for his service

 - Jim Gilchrist is running a gray market vehicle and an email consulting working groups, which are both making progress.
 - Discussion was had about what to use to access a vehicle on the kiosk.
 Concern is about address changing/tab replacement, DPPA concerns if people just use plate or VIN, and verification codes are hard to find/remember, asking for different parameters, another resource, house number was brought up as another option

I'd like to say that it is the decision of the DRIVES committee that we cannot continue to wait for important projects to take, um, time and resources from our – our large backlog of SQRs, that we – we move that this committee and Department of Revenue moves with all deliberate speed and obtain the resources so that SQRs and special projects, such as API, can move forward at a[n] expeditious rate, and that we call on the Department of Revenue, the Director of the Department of Revenue, to work with the governor and the joint budget committee on- on dollars whether that is through a supplemental, dollars that are available, or existing funds that we can do both.
