

**Class A CDL** - Any combination of vehicles with a GVWR or gross combination weight of 26,001 lbs. or more, including a towed unit(s) with a GVWR or gross vehicle weight of more than 10,000 lbs.

### Possible Endorsement Exams

**Doubles/Triples** - required to tow two or three trailers of 10,001 pounds or more  
**Tanker** - required if you intend to haul liquids or liquefied gases in bulk or intermediate bulk containers of (119 gallons or more) and an aggregate capacity of 1,000 gallons or more.  
**Hazmat** - Any driver, regardless of the vehicle Class/Group (A,B or C) who wishes to haul any material that has been designated as hazardous under 49 U.S.C. 5103 and is required to be placarded under subpart F of 49 CFR part 172; or any quantity of a material listed as a select agent or toxin 42 CFR Part 73 must add a hazardous materials endorsement to their CDL.  
**School Bus** - required if the driver wishes to operate a school bus in addition to the passenger endorsement  
**Passenger** - required if the driver wishes to transport 16 or more passengers including the driver

**Tractor-trailers** (also known as Semi, Big Rig or 18-wheeler)

Class B: Any single vehicle that has a GVWR or gross vehicle rate of 26,001 lbs. or more, or a vehicle towing a vehicle with a GVWR (or gross vehicle weight) that isn't more than 10,000 lbs.

## Possible Endorsements

**Passenger** - required if the driver wishes to transport 16 or more passengers including the driver

**School Bus** - required if the driver wishes to operate a school bus in addition to the passenger endorsement

**Hazmat** - Any driver, regardless of the vehicle Class/Group (A,B or C) who wishes to haul any material that has been designated as hazardous under 49 U.S.C. 5103 and is required to be placarded under subpart F of 49 CFR part 172; or any quantity of a material listed as a select agent or toxin 42 CFR Part 73 must add a hazardous materials endorsement to their CDL.

**Tanker** - required if you intend to haul liquids or liquefied gases in bulk or intermediate bulk containers of (119 gallons or more) and an aggregate capacity of 1,000 gallons or more.

**Passenger** - required if the driver wishes to transport 16 or more passengers including the driver
