The State will count and assign sequential page numbers for all documents submitted with the Colorado Assigned Vehicle Identification Number Application form (DR 2408). Once approved, the entire packet of documents will then be forwarded to the Colorado State Patrol who will contact you for an appointment to physically affix the VIN plate to your vehicle. The packet of documents will be returned to you at that time.

It is **your responsibility** to take this packet of documents to your County Motor Vehicle Office to apply for a Colorado title.

If any documents are missing, the County Motor Vehicle Office will not accept the application and it will be necessary for you to begin the process again. Secure and Verifiable Identification is required to obtain a title or registration in the State of Colorado. Please see the Secure and Verifiable ID form (DR 2841) for acceptable documents.

***If a bond is required, the bond must show the new Assigned Vehicle Identification Number and the Dealer's Appraisal must be submitted with the entire packet of documents submitted with the Assigned Vehicle Identification Number Application form (DR 2408).**
