

Late Fee Exemption/Reduction Request

C.R.S. 42-3-112(1.5)(b) and Code of Colorado Regulation 1 CCR 204-10 Rule 44. Late Fee Exemption

Nothing in C.R.S. 42-3-112(1.5)(b) and (3)(a) shall be construed to exempt the owner of an idled vehicle from paying any fees imposed pursuant to this article other than the late fee before again operating the vehicle on a public highway in this state or from paying any taxes imposed pursuant to this article.

Commercial Business: the late fee shall not be imposed on a vehicle subject to taxation if the person who owns the vehicle uses the vehicle in operating a commercial business and as part of the normal operation of the business, idles the vehicle so that it is not operated on any public highway in this state for at least one full registration period.

Farm Vehicle Trailer: The late fee may be waived or reduced for a farm vehicle trailer if the person who owns the farm vehicle trailer idles the trailer so that it is not operated on any public highway in this state for at least a full registration period.
