

Special Mobile Machinery (SMM) Vehicle Information Worksheet

**C.R.S. 42-1-102(60), 42-1-102(72.2), 42-1-102(93.5), 42-3-106(2) through (3),
42-3-107(15) through (18), 42-3-107(25), and 42-3-203(3)**

“Special Mobile Machinery” means machinery that is pulled, hauled, or driven over a highway and is either: a vehicle or equipment that is not designed primarily for the transportation of persons or cargo over the public highways; or a motor vehicle that may have been originally designed for the transportation of persons or cargo over the public highways, and has been redesigned or modified by the addition of mounted equipment or machinery, and is only incidentally operated or moved over the public highways. Special Mobile Machinery includes vehicles commonly used in the construction, maintenance, and repairs of roadways, the drilling of wells, and the digging of ditches. (C.R.S. 42-1-102(93.5))

“Mounted Equipment” means any item weighing more than five hundred pounds that is permanently mounted on a vehicle, including mounting by means such as welding or bolting the equipment to a vehicle. (C.R.S. 42-1-102(60))

“Power Takeoff Equipment” means equipment that is attached to a motor vehicle and is powered by the motor that powers the locomotion of the motor vehicle.(C.R.S. 42-1-102(72.2))

Every item of special mobile machinery required to be registered shall be Class F personal property. (C.R.S. 42-3-106(2)(e))

This worksheet shall be completed and turned into your County Motor Vehicle Office for SMM and/ or Mounted Equipment meeting the definitions above. This worksheet shall aid you in determining proper registration requirements and documentation required to complete the registration. Answer all questions on this worksheet.

*If owner is unable to provide MSRP and Purchase Price the County Clerk may establish taxable value by either factory list price, original retail delivered price, or information published by the property tax administrator. If Vehicle and Mounted Equipment are same year the owner may elect to register both together as SMM or the vehicle as it's proper vehicle type (GVW, Light Truck etc.) and the Mounted Equipment as SMM. If the Vehicle and Mounted Equipment are different years the vehicle will be registered as it's proper vehicle type (GVW, Light Truck etc.) and the Mounted Equipment as SMM. If the owner desires to participate in the International Registration Plan Program the Mounted Equipment must be registered as SMM separately from the vehicle. County may elect to issue a Temporary Registration Permit not to exceed sixty days to allow the owner to obtain any missing documents or information.

The weight and value of all mounted power take off equipment shall be combined with the vehicle weight and value. Title change and VIN verification may be required
