

Colorado VETS-2-TRUCKS Program

IF YOU:

Are close to military discharge or were discharged within the last year, and have experience driving heavy military trucks and have a safe driving record for at least the past 2 years.

You may qualify for a Colorado Commercial Driver License (CDL) without having to take the commercial driver skills test. (Written tests are still required. All CDLs usually require at least two tests)

BENEFITS:

- No \$200-\$400 cost of test
- No \$150-\$250 test vehicle rental
- No learner's permit

Save Time

- No need to schedule testing appointment
- Quicker entry into workforce

PROCESS:

- (1) Complete, sign and date the front page of the application for Military CDL Skills Test Waiver.
- (2) Have your Commanding Officer complete, sign and date page two.
- (3) Complete, sign and date the Colorado Division of Motor Vehicles CDL Unit 10-Year License Certification.
- (4) Enclose a copy of your Military License or Military Driving Record as additional proof of qualification.
- (5) Submit the completed forms to the Colorado DMV CDL Unit:

- (6) If you have not already done so, arrange for a Department of Transportation Medical Examination through an FMCSA Registry physician or health care facility, and get your DOT Medical Card. *www.fmcsa.dot.gov/national-registry-certified-medical-examiners-search*
- (7) Obtain a copy of the current CDL Manual online at *DMV.Colorado.gov/im-commercial-driver* and study for the General Knowledge examination and any other endorsements such as Air Brakes, or Combination to prepare for the required written tests.
- (8) Once you've qualified for the waiver, you can schedule an appointment at any full-service Driver License office, take and pass the applicable written tests, provide your DOT medical card and purchase your full privilege CDL. (Rules for proof of identity, name, age and lawful presence and residential address still apply.) Appointments can be made at *myDMV.Colorado.gov*.

Application for Military CDL Skills Test Waiver

Applicant Information								
If your military duties required you to operate a military motor vehicle that is the equivalent of a Commercial Motor Vehicle (CMV) for at least two years immediately preceding your discharge from the military, you may apply for a Commercial Driver License (CDL) skills test waiver. You will still be required to pass any CDL knowledge (written) tests. This waiver is available only for the equivalent class of vehicle and only if you either are currently active military or were active within one year of this date.
